#### **Teachers report – Joel Seaman**

- Numbers of clubs groups running. Girls group, boys group. Math / eco / coding / board game clubs
- Athletics. Basketball, volleyball, Floor hockey coming (grades 5/6), most athletics will be for grades 4 and up
- Musical rehearse twice a week
- Kids fill out form to request that they would like to be on the team, go to practices and then teams are formed.

#### **Advocacy report**

- John Street letter in process of writeup.
- LM jack Layton ferry terminal 2020 will launch new boats current plans are not kid/community/school friendly. Working with Mayor's office to meet with Mayor to talk about how the boat will be designed so that it actually makes sense for the islanders & schools. Hope to be in next couple of weeks. Should be not just beneficial for school & islanders but also for the waterfront community and also tourism.
- Scott: initial design for ferry. Needs to be able to go thru ice, have capacity, aesthetics for the 12 min ride. Design showed stairs, elevators, main floor could hold 30 cars, no space for bikes, top deck enclosed could hold 100, observation area, cold hold 1300. KPMG came in and did focus groups and all stake holders (ferry ppl, tourist, York qq assoc, islanders...) done in fall 2017. They will come back with a new design -hopefully- soon.
- Mayors office will likely be the last say.
