

IPS SCHOOL COUNCIL 2016/17 FUNDRAISING TARGETS

Our Commitment

\$15,000

Based on The Lighthouse Foundation's past fundraising trends, the list of opportunities presented by Island Public School staff, and our projections for the 2016/17 school year, IPS School Council has committed to raise **\$15,000** to forward into improvement projects between now and June.

- ★ Kindergarten Division: 10 iPad Minis (\$3,100)
- ★ Primary Division: 1 Math & Science Exploration Cart (\$3,000)
- ★ Junior Division: 1 STEM-focused Math & Science Exploration Cart (\$3,000)
- Artist in the School visit, one per classroom (\$2,500)
- Scientist in the School visit, one per classroom (\$2,000)
- Variety Village Fitness Friends school visit (\$500)
- The Groove Experience school visit (\$500)
- Blue Spruce (JK to Gr. 2) and Silver Birch (Gr. 3 to 6) literary resources (\$500)
- Flex Pro portable outdoor goal nets, one set each for primary and junior (\$400)

Items marked with ★ have already been approved for purchase using existing funds of The Lighthouse Foundation, which currently holds a balance of \$25,000.

The total for the items listed comes to \$18,600, with any difference between our amount raised and the total cost to be covered by the existing funds held by The Lighthouse Foundation.

Our Progress

\$3,878

Thus far in the 2016 school year we have raised the funds shown above through the Halloween party (\$2,321), the Gap event (est. \$700), and the poinsettia drive (\$857.31). That puts our current amount raised at \$3,878, giving us \$11,122 to go to reach our goal. (The June BBQ typically raises roughly \$8,000, so this is well within reach!)
